## Sermon Study Guide

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions.** The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

### Life Group Questions adapted from Dale Davis's commentary on 1 Samuel in the Focus on the Bible Series.

1. List the convictions about God which David demonstrates in Psalm 34 and consider the relevance of each to his situation in Gath.
2. David was concerned for his elderly parents and translated that concern into practical action. Is there a lesson in this for you?
3. Many saints have stories to tell of their desperation and God's providence. Reflect on those experiences in your life and what you learned about God.
4. Saul ordered the death of the priests, those in authority have power and should possess moral qualities. How should this encourage us to pray for local, national, and international leaders as we are exhorted to do in 1 Tim. 2:1-2?
5. How much do you owe to dear friends and encouragers like Jonathan? Identify some of them and thank God for them.
